
Types of PEPH Grantee User Accounts



The *Add New Material* screen contains an Add New Material form.

There are four sections to the Add New Material form:

1. Basic Information -Title, Abstract, Institution, PEPH Program Affiliation, Author(s), and Review Year.
2. Cataloging Information – Topics, Primary Keyword, Secondary Keywords, Publish to NIEHS website?, Viewable to other Grantees?
3. Audience Information – Language, Audience, Grade Level.
4. Material Content – Material Type (file or URL), File to Upload (if applicable), Format, File Type, subject matter expert review.

Review of Submitted Materials

- Materials are reviewed following the PEPH Resource Center Material Requirements
- A link to the Material Requirements document is on the Resource Center Landing page
