Relative to normal control littermates (N), cranial NTDs form a continuum. Encephalocoele (E) presents as a small protuberance of meninges-covered cerebral cortex on the forehead or crown. Exencephaly (X) exhibits complete exposure of the cerebrum and midbrain. Anencephaly (A) is shown by a complete absence of the brain (± a portion of the
