




### Who is covered by OSHA's HAZWOPER Standard?

The Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response Standard (HAZWOPER) applies to five distinct groups of employers and their employees. This includes any employees who are exposed or potentially exposed to hazardous substances-- including hazardous waste--and who are engaged in one of the following operations as specified by 1910,120(a)(1)(i)-s) and 1926-65(a)(1)0-y):

- dean-up operations—required by a governmental body, whether federal, state, local, or other involving hazardous substances- that are conducted at uncontrolled hazardous waste sites:
- . corrective actions involving clean-up operations at sites covered by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 (RCRA) as amended (42 U.S.C. 6901 et seq.);
- · voluntary clean-up operations at sites recognized by federal, state, local, or other governmental body as uncontrolled hazardous waste sites;
- · operations involving hazardous wastes that are conducted at treatment, storage, and disposal facilities regulated by Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations Parts 264 and 265 pursuant to RCRA, or by agencies under agreement with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to implement RCRA regulations; and

Targeted brownfields health and salety information is bard to find, but increasingly in demand because of the growing number of brownfield assessment and clean-up sites across the country.

For this reason, OSHA is preparing a new webpage that addresses worker ealth and safety at Federal Brownfields and State Voluntary Chanup Program sites. The page is designed as a focused source of information for employers, employautomation for employers, outputy-ces, and government entries that are or will be working on brownfields. One of the essential elements of this webpage is a Question and Answer (Q & A) document to provide guidance on OSHA requirements that apply during assessment and clean-

up.
