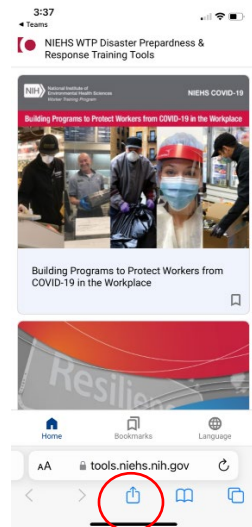
Adding the App to your Phone, Tablet, or Computer

On iOS devices (Tablet or Phone)

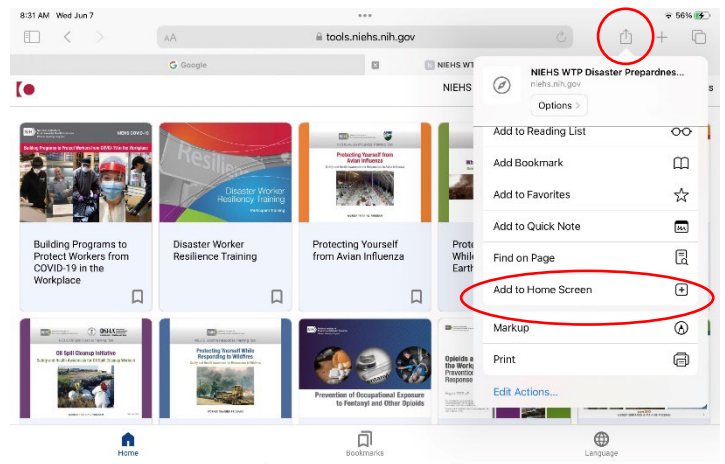
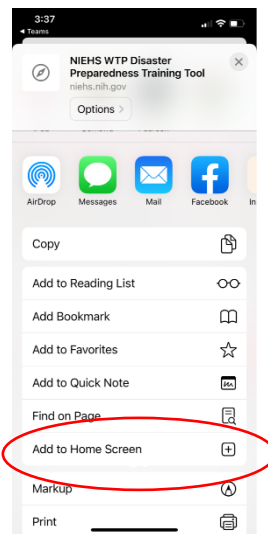
To add the app to your iPhone home screen, access the app via the **Safari browser** by entering the URL below into your browser address bar:

From the website, tap  on the bottom of your screen (or top of the screen on your iPad), then tap Add to Home Screen.

The app is now installed and available on your home screen.



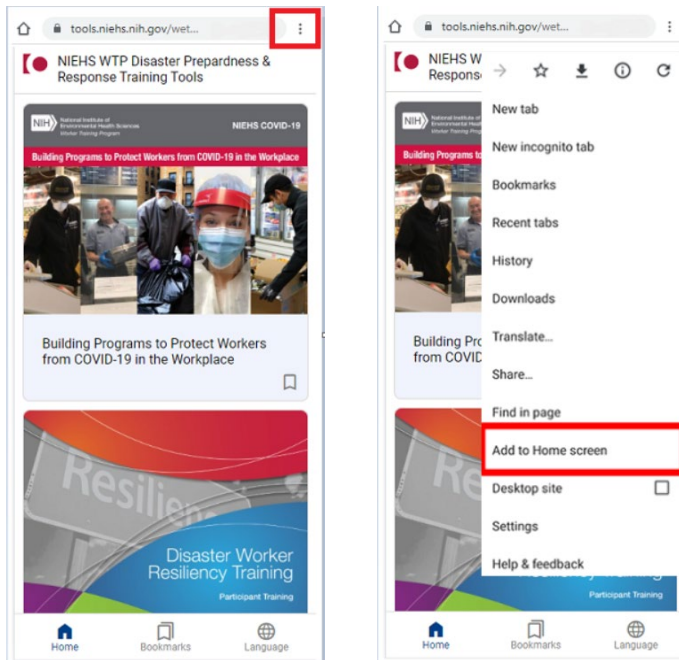

To add the app to your Android home screen, access the app via the **Chrome browser** by entering the URL below into your browser address bar:

The app is now installed and available on your home screen.

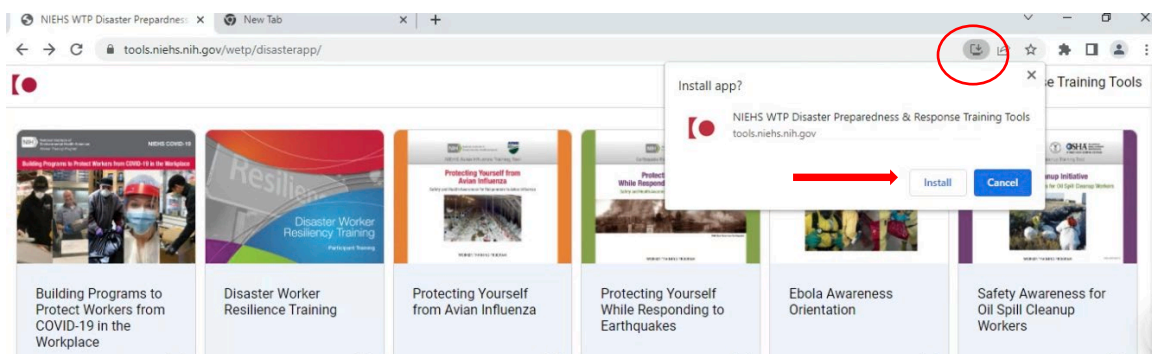


On Computers


To add the app to your Computer desktop, access the app via the **Chrome or Edge browser** by entering the URL below into your browser address bar:

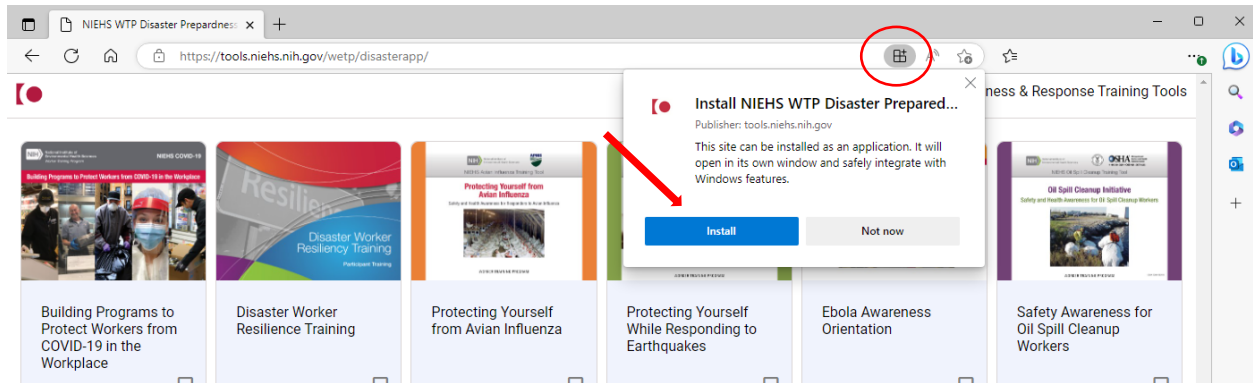

Choosing the language of preference

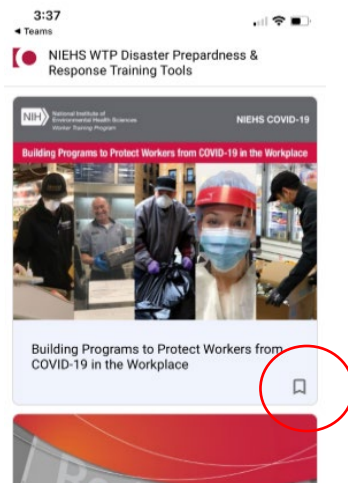
To choose the language of preference for the training tools, please click on the Languages icon  on the bottom of the screen. Choose the language of preference.
