



The IUOE National Training Fund’s Confined Spaces 101 App is now available for Apple and Android users. The app is an interactive training tool available for your smart phone that can be used anywhere, anytime. The app follows the Permit-Required Confined Space Decision Flow Chart in 29 CFR 1910.146 Appendix A, OSHA standard. The 1926 Confined Space standard released in August 2015 does not have a flow chart, but workers can reference the 1910.146 standard flow chart as a regulatory guidance tool for anyone working in confined spaces in the Construction Industry.

The app walks users through questions that will help them decide if the area is a confined space and, more importantly, a permit-required confined space. Based on the results of each decision, the confined space flow chart also provides regulatory guidance on how to best mitigate or eliminate the hazardous conditions that are inherent to confined space entries.
