SOUTH MOUNTAIN PARK

DESCRIPTION: At over 16,000 acres, South Mountain Park and Preserve is considered the largest municipal park in the country. There are more than 50 miles of trails for horseback riding, hiking and mountain biking. Dobbins Lookout, at 2,330 feet, is the highest point in the park accessible by trail. This area has a fantastic view of the Phoenix Valley. It's just over 5 miles from Central Ave to Dobbins Lookout.

HOURS: Open daily 5am – 7pm (entrance gates close) Trails remain open until 11pm.

MYSTERY CASTLE

DESCRIPTION: Built in the 1930's by Boyce Luther Gulley for his daughter, who still lives there till this day. This three-story castle is made of stone, adobe, automobile parts and goat milk.

CHINESE CULTURAL CENTER

MUSICAL INSTRUMENT MUSEUM
