




Online Survey Results

- Identifying high risk areas
- Guiding and educating members
- Sanitation and social distancing
- Demanding effective mitigation



Phone Interview Results

Reported challenges with:

- Logging on
- Connecting to audio
- Break-out rooms
- Sound and video quality



Phone Interview Results

Contributing factors:

- Location
- Cost and time of travelling
- Comfort levels in remote environment



Recommended Actions

- Email list
- Early log-on
- Online tutorials
- Continue evaluation
