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# COVID-19 Awareness – Level Training

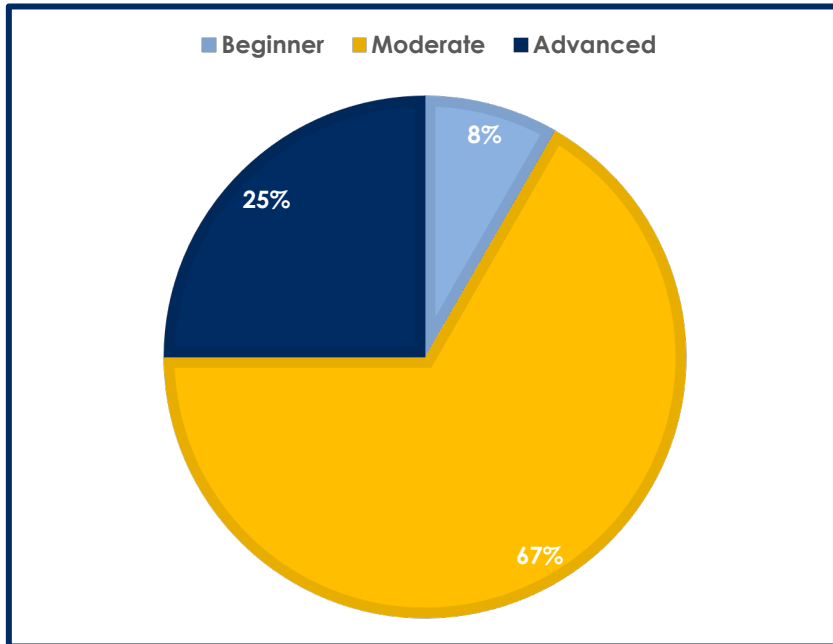
- Designed to inform workers of how to protect themselves from exposure to the COVID-19 virus

# Data Collection

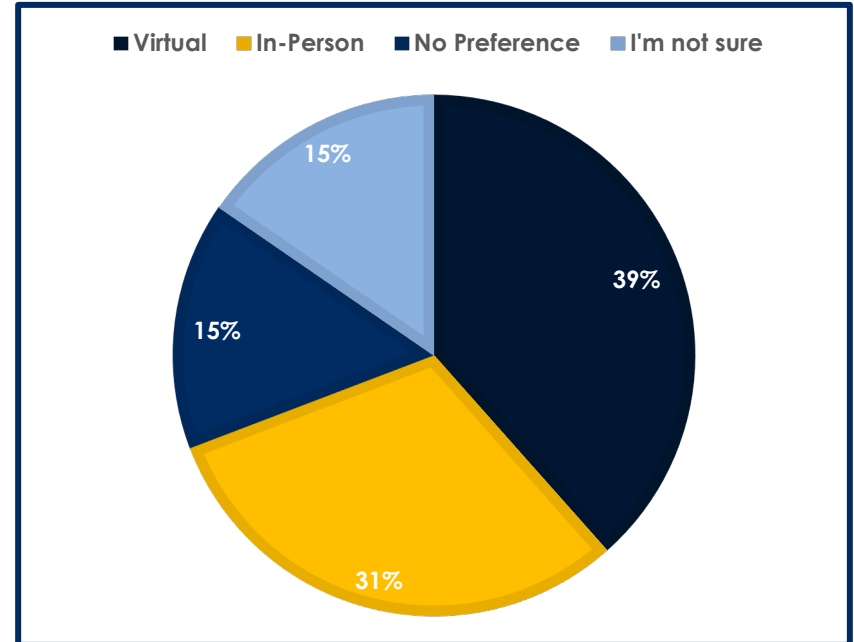
- Online Surveys

- Identifying high risk areas

# Phone Interview Results

## Reported challenges with:

- Logging on
- Connecting to audio
- Break-out rooms
- Sound and video quality

# Phone Interview Results

## Contributing factors:

- Location
- Cost and time of travelling
- Comfort levels in remote environment

- Email list
- Early log-on
- Online tutorials
- Continue evaluation
