COVID-19 Recovery Centers – DMS Reporting

- Training Data
 - Supplemental Funding: Use "COVID RECOVERY CENTERS"
 - For data uploads, this must be added to the spreadsheet for the current 2021 program year. Watch for instructions from Lynn Albert this week on the DMS Users listsery.
 - It is already in the 2022 program year
 - Special Circumstances: Use "CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19 SARS-CoV-2)"
 - Remarks
 - Refer to the existing FAQ (next slides)
 - Use Remarks field as needed

DMS FAQ – Tagging as COVID-19 Funding

How do we note that the class is related to COVID-19 specifically?

There are two options for designating a course as COVID-19:

- DMS COVID-19 Supplemental Funding
 - Any training completed using COVID-19 supplemental funds MUST select the "Coronavirus (COVID-19, SARS Cov-2)" or "COVID RECOVERY CENTERS" option under Supplemental Funding in the DMS.

- DMS COVID-19 Special Circumstances
 - All trainings under any funding stream related to the topic of COVID-19 MUST select the "Coronavirus (COVID-19, SARS Cov-2)" option under Special Circumstances in the DMS.

DMS FAQ – Tagging as COVID-19 Funding

How do we determine what qualifies for a COVID-19/Coronavirus class for the DMS? For example, an eighthour class with one or two hours of COVID-19 training.

- If the content is delivered using COVID-19 funding
 - It should be broken out as a separate class in the DMS, to reflect the use of this separate stream of funding that must be tracked separately.
 - Select Coronavirus/COVID-19 for BOTH the special circumstances and supplemental funding
 - Or "COVID Recovery Centers" as applicable for supplemental funding
- If the content is NOT being delivered with COVID-19 funding
 - Check the Coronavirus/COVID-19 special circumstances if at least half the class was spent on COVID-19.
 - Use the remarks field to provide a comment, such as "half day spent on COVID" We understand that short modules on COVID-19 may become a routine part of health and safety classes right now, and we do not expect to track everything.

COVID-19 Recovery Centers – DMS Reporting

- Progress Reports IX. Supplemental Progress/Carryover
 - Describe your activities under the supplement as usual, with a focus on
 - Training course delivery
 - Work with key partnerships to reach communities at high-risk of COVID-19 or have less access to health and safety information
 - Coordination activities with local service delivery and emergency response organizations, such as public health departments, testing and vaccine locations, mental health services
 - Evaluation or assessment activities
