- Decrease in number of doctors





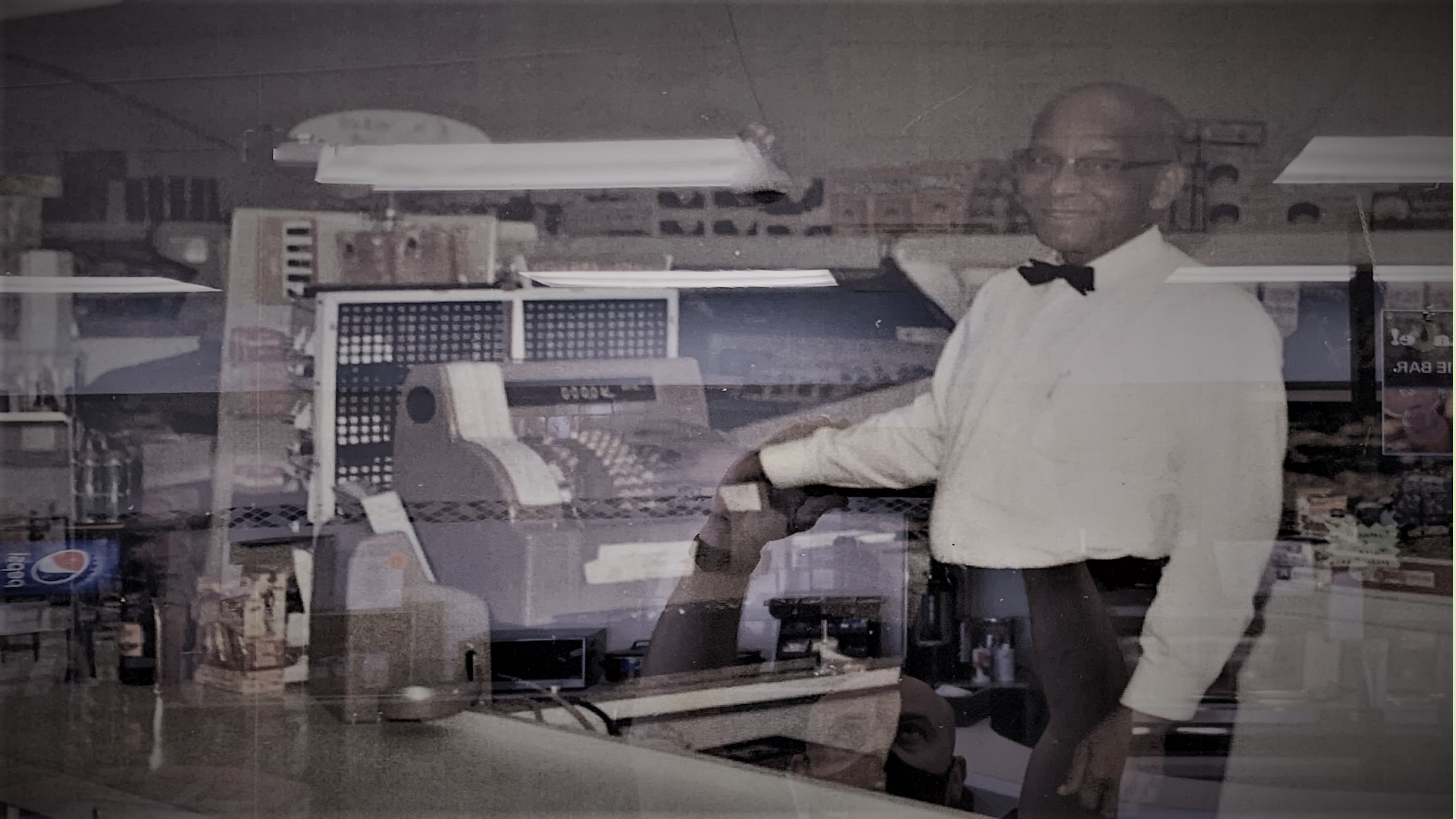

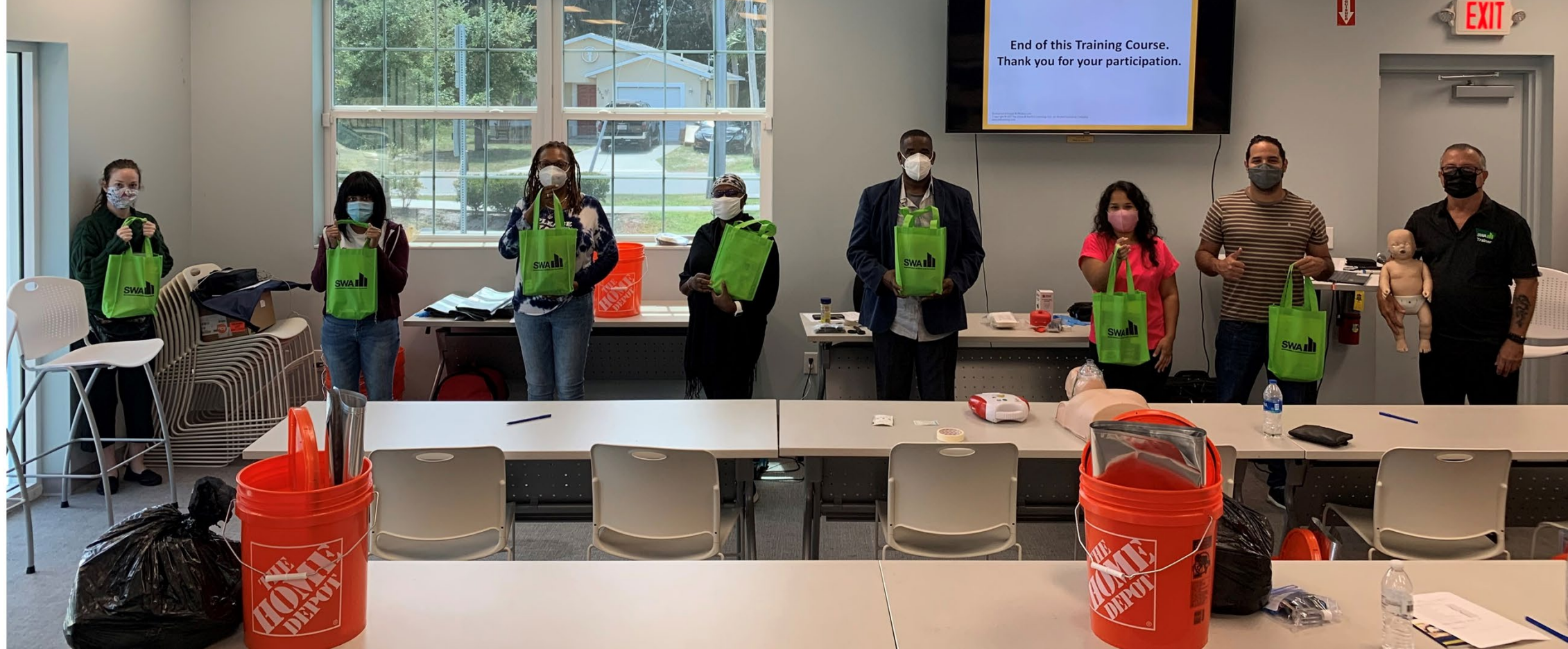
